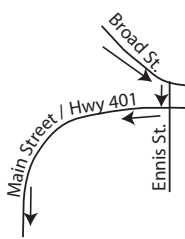


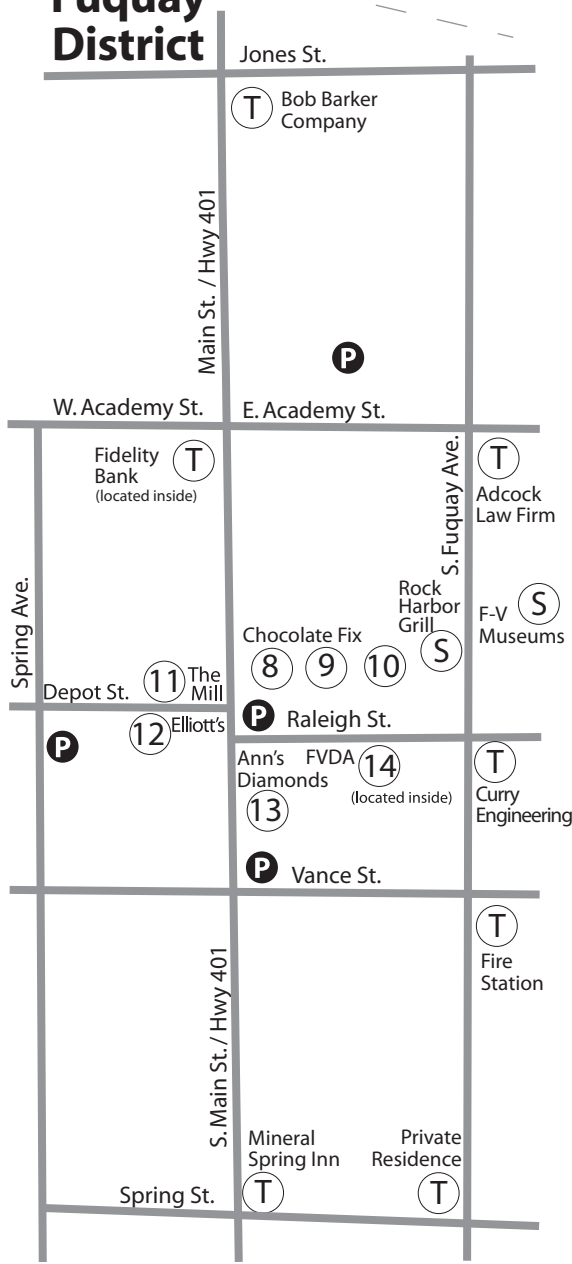
Art Walk
